DAY 1 ARRIVE CAPE TOWN

Upon arrival in Cape Town International Airport, meet and greet by our representative. Transfer to your hotel for check in (please note rooms might not be ready for check in due to early arrival.) Rest of the day is free at leisure. You might wish to proceed to Victoria & Alfred waterfront for some shopping.

DAY 2 CAPE TOWN- HALF-DAY CAPE TOWN CITY TOUR

Breakfast at hotel. Proceed for a Scheduled Authentic Cape Town city tour. Sense the depth of history as you drive past Parliament Buildings, City Hall and the Slave Lodge before stopping for a short visit of the Castle of Good Hope (optional), originally built as a maritime replenishment station and now the oldest surviving colonial building in South Africa! Alternatively we walk around the Grand Parade square which has its own historical significance. We hear of the brief history of District Six en-route to a visit at the Company Gardens where we walk through the landscaped gardens. Learn more about the history of the Bo-Kaap and its people as we move up the cobblestoned hills to the Malay Quarter, and marvel at the ice-cream colours of the quaint Bo-Kaap homes. Trace the moves of a professional diamond cutter as he creates every girl's dream stone with a visit to a diamond cutting factory. After learning more about the history of diamonds and gold in South Africa, we drive past the V&A Waterfront, Cape Town Stadium, Sea Point, Clifton and Camps Bay as we make our way to Table Mountain where you have the option of either admiring the views from the lower cable station or purchasing a ticket (for own account) to reach the summit. After delighting in this photo opportunity, return to the hotel or stay on top of the mountain and find your own way back to your hotel.

DAY 3 CAPE TOWN - FULL DAY PENINSULA TOUR

Bring your camera; guests are headed for Cape Point at the southwestern tip of the Cape Peninsula, and the most spectacular views in the world. The drive there is just as inspiring, passing steep mountains, secluded coves and sweeping beaches, as well as villages and fishing communities.

This tour begins with a scenic drive along the Atlantic coast, passing through the cosmopolitan suburbs of Sea Point and Camps Bay with its glorious views of the Twelve Apostles, part of the Table Mountain range. Guests will continue to the fishing village of Hout Bay, one of Cape Towns best-kept secrets. Here there is an option to take a short boat trip to Seal Island (for own account & time permitting) to view the Cape Fur Seals, which inhabit the island. From here guests will travel to the Cape Point Nature Reserve, comprising over 17,300 acres of indigenous fauna and flora. Here guests can see a variety of wildlife that includes baboons, Reebok, Cape Mountain zebra, bontebok and the elusive eland. The reserve is also one of the worlds largest breeding grounds for tortoises. Birdwatchers, too, will find many fine species to observe.

The majestic coastline offers drama worthy of being called Nature's Greatest Show. Guests will be able to see the union of the Atlantic and Indian Oceans (as per legend) and may even feel the brisk wind that is dubbed the Cape Doctor for its presumed curative powers. Following the coastline along False Bay, guests will return to Cape Town by way of Simons Town, where they will visit the Penguin colony at Boulders Beach (for own account) and Fish Hoek fishing village. Guests will return to Cape Town, passing the University of Cape Town and the Groote Schuur Hospital
